36	SECTION 3. APPR	ROPRIATION - ALTERNATIVE FUELS AND ENERG	GY GRANTS. There

1	is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Agriculture Department, to be payable		
2	from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, the		
3	following:		
4	(A) for Alternative Fuels and Energy grants, in a sum not to exceed		
5	\$15,000,000.		
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7	SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - FACILITY IMPROVEMENTS AND CONSTRUCTION -		
8	LIVESTOCK AND POULTRY. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas		
9	Agriculture Department - Livestock and Poultry, to be payable from the		
10	General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, the		
11	following:		
12	(A) for Camp Couchdale for improvements to facilities, maintenance,		
13	sewer system connection, facility renovation, roof replacement, equipment		
14	including but not limited to heating, ventilation, and air conditioning		
15	units, road resurfacing and construction of buildings which are used to		
16	support statewide Future Farmers of America activities, in a sum not to		
17	exceed\$15,000,000.		
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19	SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS		
20	CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.		
21	Notwithstanding any other rules, regulations or provision of law to the		
22	contrary the appropriations authorized in Sections 2, 3, and 4 of this Act		
23	shall not be restricted by requirements that may be applicable to other		
24	programs currently administered. New rules and regulations may be adopted t		
25	carry out the intent of the General Assembly regarding the appropriations		
26	authorized in Sections 2, 3, and 4 of this Act.

28	SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS		
29	CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.		
30	Notwithstanding any other rules, regulations or provision of law to the		
31	contrary the appropriations authorized in Section 1 of this Act shall not be		
32	restricted by requirements that may be applicable to other programs currently		
33	administered. New rules and regulations may be adopted to carry out the		
34	intent of the General Assembly regarding the appropriations authorized in		
35	Section 1 of this Act.		
36	No less than thirty (30) days prior to the distribution of any funds		

appropriated by Section 1 of this act, the director of the agency shall notify the Speaker of the House of Representatives of the name and address of each recipient and the amount that is being distributed to each recipient. The grant amount authorized for each County Fair by Section 1 of this act shall be \$7,200 and the grant amount authorized for each District Fair by Section 1 of this act shall be \$48,000. A determination shall be made as to whether the actual available funding meets, exceeds or falls below the total authorized grant amount for all County and District Fairs by Section 1 of this act. Next, the Department will determine by what percentage the actual funds available exceed or fall below the total grant amounts authorized by Section 1 of this act. If actual funding is either above or below the total authorized grant amount for all County and District Fairs authorized by Section 1 of this act, each County and District Fair's grant amount will be adjusted by the percentage the actual funds available exceed or fall below the total authorized grant amount.

SECTION 7. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

(B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.

1	SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
2	Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
3	contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
4	which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
5	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
6	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
7	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
8	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
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10	SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
11	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
12	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
13	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2013 is essential to the operation of
14	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
15	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
16	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2013 could work irreparable harm
17	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
18	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
19	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
20	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2013.
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
