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2	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 5-73-320 is amended to read as follows:		
3	5-73-320. License for certain members of the Arkansas National Guard		
4	or a reserve component or active duty military personnel.		
5	(a) The Department of Arkansas State Police may issue a license unde		
6	this subchapter to a person who:		
7	(1) Is currently serving as a federally recognized commissione		
8	or noncommissioned officer of the National Guard or a reserve component of		
9	the armed forces of the United States or an active duty member of the armed		
10	forces of the United States;		
11	(2) Submits the following documents:		
12	(A) A completed concealed handgun license application as		
13	prescribed by the department;		
14	(B) A form specified by the Director of the Department of		
15	Arkansas State Police reflecting the fingerprints of the soldier or airman		
16	applicant;		
17	(C) A properly completed and dated certificate from a		
18	concealed handgun carry training instructor who is registered with the		
19	department;		
20	(D) A live fire qualification issued or granted by a		
21	branch of the United States armed forces or in lieu of a live fire		
22	qualification a letter		
23	(C) A dated letter and personally signed by a		
24	commanding officer or his or her designee stating that the soldier or airman		
25	applicant:		
26	(i) Is a current member of the National Guard		
27	or a reserve component of the armed forces of the United States or an active		
28	duty member of the armed forces of the United States;		
29	(ii) Is of good character and sound judgment;		
30	and		
31	(iii) <del>Is not disqualified by state or federal</del>

4	signed and dated within one (1) year of the application date by a range

6	(E) A copy of the face or photograph side of a current
7	United States Uniformed Services military identification card, if the
8	applicant is for a member of the armed forces; and
9	(F) An electronic passport-style photo of the applicant,
10	if the applicant does not hold an Arkansas driver's license or identification
11	card; and
12	(3) Submits any required application fee fees.
13	(b)(1) After July 31, 2007, a license issued under this section
14	expires five (5) years from the date of issuance or upon the expiration date
15	of the military identification card of the soldier or airman, whichever
16	occurs first.
17	$(2)(\Lambda)$ A license issued under this section is renewable for a
18	period of five (5) years under the provisions of § 5-73-313 upon satisfaction
19	of the requirements described in subsection (a) of this section.
20	(B) After December 31, 2007, a license issued under this
21	section is required to bear a digital photograph of the soldier or airman.
22	(e)(b) Except as otherwise specifically stated in this section, the
23	license issued under this section is subject to the provisions of this
24	subchapter and any rules promulgated under § 5-73-317.
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
