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11	22-6-120. Adopt a Document Program.		
12	(a) The Adopt a Document Program is established to be administered by		
13	the Commissioner of State Lands.		
14	(b)(1) The Commissioner of State Lands may:		
15	(A) Obtain funding from private donations and charities to		
16	protect documents in his or her custody; and		
17	(B) Sell duplicates or copies of maps, plats, and other		
18	documents in his or her possession or in the possession of a state agency.		
19	(2) The donations, proceeds of sales under subdivision (b)(1)(B)		
20	of this section, and other funds of the Commissioner of State Lands shall be		
21	deposited into a cash fund account and used to preserve and protect		
22	documents, maps, field notes, and survey records in his or her possession.		
23	(c) For the sole purpose of managing the Adopt a Document Program, the		
24	Commissioner of State Lands is considered an eligible charitable organization		
25	under 26 U.S.C. § 501(c)(3) for the purpose of preserving historic maps and		
26	documents under the custody of the Commissioner of State Lands.		
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28	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 26-37-101(a)(1), concerning the		
29	certification of tax-delinquent lands, is amended to read as follows:		
30	(a)(l) <u>(A)</u> All lands upon which the taxes have not been paid for one		
31	(1) year following the date the taxes were due, October 15, shall be		
32	forfeited to the state and transmitted by certification to the Commissioner		
33	of State Lands for collection or sale.		
34	(B) The Commissioner of State lands may accept an		
35	electronic certification of tax delinquent parcels from a county.		
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
