## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF ARKANSAS

11 THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2014; AND FOR OTHER

## Subtitle

15 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF ARKANSAS  
16 STATE POLICE - SCRAP METAL INVESTIGATION  
17 DIVISION APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2013-2014  
18 FISCAL YEAR.  
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22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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### SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - SCRAP METAL INVESTIGATION DIVISION.

24 There is hereby established for the Department of Arkansas State Police -  
25 Scrap Metal Investigation Division for the 2013-2014 fiscal year, the  
26 following maximum number of regular employees.

### SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - SCRAP METAL INVESTIGATION DIVISION. There



1 is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas State Police, to be  
 2 payable from the Department of Arkansas State Police Fund, for personal  
 3 services and operating expenses of the Department of Arkansas State Police -  
 4 Scrap Metal Investigation Division for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014,  
 5 the following:

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 21 *SECTION 3. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS*  
 22 *CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUNDING*  
 23 *TRANSFER. Immediately upon the effective date of this Act, the Chief Fiscal*  
 24 *Officer of the State shall transfer on his or her books and those of the*  
 25 *State Treasurer and the Auditor of the State one million two hundred fifty*  
 26 *three thousand one hundred thirty three dollars (\$1,253,133) from the General*  
 27 *Revenue Allotment Reserve Fund to the Department of Arkansas State Police*  
 28 *Fund to be used solely for personal services and operating expenses of the*  
 29 *Scrap Metal Investigation Division.*

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 31 *SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds*  
 32 *authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency*  
 33 *and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and*  
 34 *the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and*  
 35 *Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary*  
 36 *Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal*

1 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
2 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
3 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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5 *SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT.* It is the intent of the General  
6 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
7 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
8 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
9 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
10 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
11 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
12 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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14 *SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE.* It is found and determined by the General  
15 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
16 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
17 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2013 is essential to the operation of  
18 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
19 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
20 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2013 could work irreparable harm  
21 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
22 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
23 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
24 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2013.
