1 of the juvenile in the home, such as benefits under the Transitional 2 Employment Assistance Program, § 20-76-401, and food stamps Supplemental 3 Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP); and 4 (b) Receive child support or any federal benefits paid on behalf of the juvenile in the relative or fictive kin's 5 6 home; and 7 (iv) If the relative's relative or fictive kin's 8 home is not fully licensed as a foster home after six (6) months of the 9 placement of the juvenile and the siblings or step-siblings in the home: 10 (a) The department shall remove the juvenile 11 and any of the siblings or step-siblings from the relative's relative or 12 fictive kin's home and close the relative's relative or fictive kin's 13 provisional foster home; or 14 (b) The court shall remove custody from the 15 department and grant custody of the juvenile to the relative or fictive kin 16 subject to the limitations outlined in subdivision (b)(4) of this section. 17 18 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 9-28-108(a), concerning the placement of 19 juveniles, is amended to read as follows: 20 (a) As used in this section;: (1) "Fictive kin" means a person not related to a child by blood 21 22 or marriage, but who has a strong positive emotional tie to a child and has a 23 positive role in the child's life, such as a godparent, neighbor, or family 24 friend; and 25 (2) "relative" "Relative" means a person within the fifth degree of kinship by virtue of blood or adoption. 26 27 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 9-28-108(c)(4), concerning the placement of 28 29 juveniles, is amended to read as follows: 30 (4)(A) The juvenile shall remain in a licensed or approved 31 foster home, shelter, or facility or an exempt child welfare agency as 32 defined under § 9-28-402 until: 33 (i) The home is opened as a regular foster home; 34 (ii) The home is opened as a provisional foster 35 home, if the person is a relative or fictive kin to one (1) of the children 36 in the sibling group, including step-siblings; or

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1 (iii) The court grants custody of the juvenile to 2 the relative or person fictive kin after a written approved home study is 3 presented to the court. 4 (B) For placement with a relative or fictive kin: 5 (i) The juvenile and his or her siblings or step-6 siblings may be placed in the home of a relative or fictive kin of the 7 juvenile on a provisional basis no more than six (6) months pending the home 8 of the relative or fictive kin being opened as a regular foster home; 9 (ii) If the relative or fictive kin chooses to have 10 his or her home opened as a provisional foster home, the relative or fictive 11 kin shall not be paid a board payment until: 12 The relative or fictive kin meets all of (a) 13 the foster home requirements; and The home of the relative or fictive kin is 14 (b) 15 opened as a regular foster home; 16 (iii) The relative or fictive kin may apply for and 17 receive benefits that the relative or fictive kin may be entitled to based on 18 the placement of the juvenile in the home, such as benefits under the 19 Transitional Employment Assistance Program, § 20-76-401, and food stamps 20 Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), until the home of the 21 relative or fictive kin is opened as a regular foster home; and 22 (iv) If the home of the relative or fictive kin is 23 not fully licensed as a foster home after six (6) months of the placement of 24 the juvenile and any siblings or step-siblings in the home: 25 (a) The department shall remove the juvenile and any siblings or step-siblings from the relative's relative or fictive 26 27 kin's home and close the provisional foster home of the relative or fictive 28 kin; or 29 (b) The court shall remove custody of the juvenile and any siblings or step-siblings from the department and grant 30 31 custody to the relative or fictive kin subject to the limitations outlined in subdivision (c)(5) of this section. 32 33 34 SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 9-28-402(15), concerning the definition of 35 "provisional foster home", is amended to read as follows:

(15) "Provisional foster home" means a foster home opened for no

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1	more than six (6) months by the Division of Children and Family Services of		
2	the Department of Human Services for a relative or fictive kin of a child in		
3	the custody of the division after it:		
4	(A) Conducts a health and safety check, including a		
5	central registry check and a criminal background check or a check with local		
6	law enforcement, of the relative's relative or fictive kin's home; and		
7	(B) Performs a visual inspection of the home of the		
8	relative or fictive kin to verify that the relative or fictive kin and the		
9	home $\underline{\text{will}}$ meet the standards for opening a regular foster home;
