15	TO REVISE THE LAW ON REIMBURSEMENT TO
16	FIRE DEPARTMENTS FOR CERTAIN SERVICES
17	PROVIDED.
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20	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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22	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 14-53-102(b), concerning accident response
23	and fire fighting by a municipal fire department beyond municipal limits, is
24	amended to add an additional subdivision to read as follows:
25	(3) The city or town may seek payment or reimbursement from the
26	property owner involved or the county after the ninety-day period for one
27	hundred percent (100%) of the expendable resources the city or town used to
28	respond to an accident if the accident involved personal property only.
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30	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code $\$$ 20-22-901(a)(1), concerning the duty of a
31	volunteer fire department to respond, is amended to read as follows:
32	(a)(1) $\underline{(A)}$ Upon receipt of a report of an uncontrolled fire or a 911 or
33	other emergency call reporting a fire, it shall be the duty of volunteer fire
34	departments operating within the State of Arkansas to respond to, attempt to
35	control, and put out all fires occurring within their respective districts
36	involving any real or personal property, whether or not that property is

1	owned by members of the fire district.
2	(B) The volunteer fire department may seek payment or
3	reimbursement from a member or nonmember of the fire district for one hundred
4	percent (100%) of the expendable resources the department used to respond to
5	an accident under subdivision (a)(1)(A) of this section if the accident
6	involved personal property only.
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8	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 20-22-901(b)(2), concerning a fire on
9	property owned by a nonmember of a volunteer fire department, is amended to
10	read as follows:
11	(2)(A) A claim for services in responding to a fire or accident
12	involving only personal property shall be allowed only for personal property
13	of nonmembers.
14	(B) The claimed amount under subdivision (b)(2)(A) of this
15	section shall not exceed eight hundred dollars (\$800) one thousand <i>two</i>
16	hundred dollars (\$1,200).
17	(C)(i) A claim under subdivision (b)(2)(A) of this section
18	shall be supported by a completed and attached Uniform Fire Department
19	Insurance Reimbursement Billing Form.
20	(ii) The Arkansas Fire Protection Services Board
21	shall adopt rules to create the form and the allowable rates for
22	reimbursement under this subdivision (b)(2).
23	(iii) The board shall use the Schedule of Equipment
24	Rates published by the Federal Emergency Management Agency of the United
25	States Department of Homeland Security, as in effect on January 1, 2013.
