27	removes any books or	other materials from any library owned	by the state or

30	replacement costs of	lost books and library materials within	the time
31	prescribed by the lib	rary rules.	
32	(2) Howe	ver, before a charge of violating the p	rovisions of this
33	section shall be file	ed against any person, the library shall	send written
34	notice, by ordinary m	nail, addressed to the last known addres	s of the person
35	who checked out or ot	herwise removed the books or materials	from the library,
36	notifying the person	that if the books or materials are not	returned to the

1	library within thirty (30) days from the date of the notice, charges will be
2	filed against the person under the provisions of this section and upon
3	conviction the person may be fined in an amount as provided in this section.
4	(b)(1) Any person violating the provisions of this section shall be
5	guilty of a violation and subject to a fine of not less than ten dollars
6	(\$10.00) nor more than one hundred dollars (\$100).
7	(2) Each violation of this section shall constitute a separate
8	offense.

10	SECTION 2. DO NOT CODIFY. The enactment and adoption of this act
11	shall not repeal, expressly or impliedly, the acts passed at the regular
12	session of the Eighty-Ninth General Assembly. All such acts shall have full
13	force and effect, and so far as those acts intentionally vary from or
14	conflict with any provision contained in this act, those acts shall have the
15	effect of subsequent acts amending or repealing the appropriate parts of the
16	Arkansas Code of 1987.
