21	SECTION 1. Ar	kansas Code § 7-4-103, is amended to rep	peal subsection
22	(b), which has been	superseded by the procedures established	d by § 7-4-102, to
23	read as follows:		
24	(a) In the ev	ent of a vacancy or disqualification on	the part of any
25	state or county chai	r for either the majority party or a min	nority party, the
26	state vice chair or	county vice chair of the party in which	the vacancy
27	occurs shall act as	county chair or state chair, as the case	e may be, for all
28	of the purposes set	out in § 7-4-101 and this section until	a new county
29	chair or state chair	is selected by the parties.	
30	(b) In the ev	ent that no county chair or county vice	-chair has been
31	elected in any of th	e several counties of Arkansas for eithe	e r the majority
32	party or a minority	party by the fiftieth calendar day befor	re any general
33	election, then and i	n that event, the State Board of Electic	on Commissioners
34	shall have authority	to elect by majority vote qualified per	rsons from the
35	county committee of	the majority or a minority party so affe	ected to fill the
36	wacancies whether or	not the vacancies are caused by failure	e to elect or by

1	death, resignation, or disqualification.

3	SECTION 2. DO NOT CODIFY. The enactment and adoption of this act
4	shall not repeal, expressly or impliedly, the acts passed at the regular
5	session of the Eighty-Ninth General Assembly. All such acts shall have full
6	force and effect, and so far as those acts intentionally vary from or
7	conflict with any provision contained in this act, those acts shall have the
8	effect of subsequent acts amending or repealing the appropriate parts of the
9	Arkansas Code of 1987.
