6	(iii)(a) For cities of one hundred fifty thousand		
7	(150,000) population and over, the jurisdictional area will be three (3)		
8	miles beyond the corporate limits.		
9	(b) Upon July 3, 1989, no city with a		
10	population in excess of one hundred fifty thousand (150,000) persons and		
11	which is situated on a navigable stream shall exercise any zoning authority		
12	outside the boundaries of the county wherein it is located without the		
13	approval of the quorum court of the county wherein the city is not located		
14	and the approval of the governing bodies of all other cities having zoning		
15	authority over the area.		
16	(3) Cities having a population of eight thousand (8,000) persons		
17	or less:		
18	(A) Shall have a jurisdictional area that does not exceed		
19	one (1) mile beyond the corporate limits; and		
20	(B) Shall not exercise any zoning authority outside the		
21	corporate limits.		
22	$\frac{(B)}{(4)}$ The city populations will be based on the latest		
23	available United States most recent federal decennial census data.		
24	(C) The provisions of subdivision (a)(2) of this section		
25	shall not restrict the powers of any city currently exercising the authority		
26	authorized under this subdivision.		
27	(b)(1) The planning commission shall designate the area within the		
28	territorial jurisdiction for which it will prepare plans, ordinances, and		
29	regulations.		
30	(2) A description of the boundaries of the area shall be filed		
31	with the city clerk and with the county recorder.
