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4	SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
5	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that it is the state's		
6	constitutional obligation to provide a general, suitable, and efficient free		
7	system of public schools in the state; that the public school funding		
8	distribution changes in this act are necessary to ensure that proper funding		
9	is provided to public schools and school districts; and that this act is		
10	immediately necessary so that public schools and school districts will		
11	receive the amount of funding provided under this act for the 2013-2014		
12	school year. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being		
13	immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and		
14	safety shall become effective on July 1, 2013.
