30	(1) "Athletic	c activity" means a varsity	sport or another
31	competitive sports-related	d contest, game, event, or	exhibition that involves
32	an individual student or	teams of students either amo	ong schools within the
33	resident school district o	or between schools outside o	of the resident school
34	district;		
35	(2) "Home-scl	nooled student" means a stud	dent legally enrolled in
36	an Arkansas home school;		

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2	(3) "Interscholastic activity" means an activity between schools		
3	subject to regulations of the Arkansas Activities Association that is:		
4	(A) Outside the regular curriculum of a school district,		
5	including without limitation an athletic activity, a fine arts program, or a		
6	special interest club or group; and		
7	(B) Taught by an individual with a minimum of a high		
8	school diploma;		
9	(4) "Parent" is a legal guardian or legal custodian;		
10	(5) "Resident school" is the school to which the student would		
11	be assigned by the resident school district; and		
12	(6) "Resident school district" means the school district in		
13	which the home-schooled student's parent resides as determined under § 6-18-		
14	<u>202.</u>		
15	(c) A home-schooled student shall not participate in interscholastic		
16	activities at a public school other than the student's resident school.		
17	(d) A resident school district may permit a home-schooled student to		
18	participate in an interscholastic activity if the home-schooled student or		
19	his or her parent advises the principal of the resident school in writing of		
20	the student's request to participate in the interscholastic activity before		
21	the signup, tryout, or participation deadlines established for students		
22	enrolled in the resident school.		
23	(e) The principal of the resident school shall approve or disapprove		
24	the written request within ten (10) days of receiving the written request and		
25	the information and documentation required by this section.		
26	(f) If a home-schooled student's written request to participate in the		
27	interscholastic activity is approved under this section, the student:		
28	(1) Although not guaranteed participation in an interscholastic		
29	activity, shall have an equal opportunity to try out and participate in		
30	interscholastic activities without discrimination; and		
31	(2) Shall not participate unless he or she meets the criteria		
32	for participation in the interscholastic activity that apply to students		
33	enrolled in the resident school district, including:		
34	(A) Tryout criteria;		
35	(B) Non-academic criteria, including without limitation		
36	standards of behavior and codes of conduct;		

1	(C) Academic and co-curricular criteria, including without		
2	limitation demonstrating and maintaining academic eligibility by obtaining:		
3	(i) A minimum test score of the thirtieth percentile		
4	on a nationally recognized norm-referenced test in the previous twelve (12)		
5	months:		
6	(ii) A minimum score on a test approved by the State		
7	Board of Education; or		
8	(iii) A minimum score on a test approved by the		
9	Arkansas Activities Association;		
10	(D) Practice times;		
11	(E) Required drug testing;		
12	(F) Permission slips, waivers, and physical exams; and		
13	(G) Participation or activity fees.		
14	(g) A home-schooled student who participates in an interscholastic		
15	activity may be:		
16	(1) Counted as an enrolled student by the resident school		
17	district; and		
18	(2) Transported by the resident school district to and from		
19	interscholastic activities as the resident school district transports other		
20	students who are enrolled in the resident school.		
21	(h) A student who transfers to a home school from an Arkansas		
22	Activities Association member school during a period that the student is		
23	academically ineligible to participate in an interscholastic activity is not		
24	eligible to participate in an interscholastic activity in a resident school		
25	until the beginning of the following school year.		
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
