15	(c) A home-schooled student shall not participate in interscholastic		
16	activities at a public school other than the student's resident school.		
17	(d) A resident school district may permit a home-schooled student to		
18	participate in an interscholastic activity if the home-schooled student or		
19	his or her parent advises the principal of the resident school in writing of		
20	the student's request to participate in the interscholastic activity before		
21	the signup, tryout, or participation deadlines established for students		
22	enrolled in the resident school.		
23	(e) The principal of the resident school shall permit a home-schooled		
24	student to pursue participation in an interscholastic activity of the		
25	resident school if the student or the student's parent:		
26	(1) Before the signup, tryout, or participation deadlines		
27	established for students enrolled in the resident school, provides to the		
28	principal a notice of the student's desire to pursue participation; and		
29	(2) Informs the principal in the notice that the student has		
30	demonstrated academic eligibility by obtaining:		
31	(A) A minimum test score of the thirtieth percentile on a		
32	nationally recognized norm-referenced test in the previous twelve (12)		
33	months;		
34	(B) A minimum score on a test approved by the State Board		
35	of Education; or		
36	(C) A minimum score on a test approved by the Arkansas

3	interscholastic activity is approved under this section, the student:		
4	(1) Although not guaranteed participation in an interscholastic		
5	activity, shall have an equal opportunity to try out and participate in		
6	interscholastic activities without discrimination; and		
7	(2) Shall not participate unless he or she meets the criteria		
8	for participation in the interscholastic activity that apply to students		
9	enrolled in the resident school district, including:		
10	(A) Tryout criteria;		
11	(B) Standards of behavior and codes of conduct; and		
12	(C) The academic criteria under subdivision (e)(2) of this		
13	section;		
14	(D) Practice times;		
15	(E) Required drug testing;		
16	(F) Permission slips, waivers, and physical exams; and		
17	(G) Participation or activity fees.		
18	(g) A home-schooled student who participates in an interscholastic		
19	activity may be:		
20	(1) Counted as an enrolled student by the resident school		
21	<u>district;</u>		
22	(2) Required to be at school not more than one (1) period per		
23	school day if necessary for insurance purposes; and		
24	(3) Transported by the resident school district to and from		
25	interscholastic activities as the resident school district transports other		
26	students who are enrolled in the resident school.		
27	(h) A student who transfers to a home school from an Arkansas		
28	Activities Association member school during a period that the student is		
29	academically ineligible to participate in an interscholastic activity is not		
30	eligible to participate in an interscholastic activity in a resident school		
31	until the beginning of the following school year.
