26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

28 SECTION 1. The purpose of this act is to require revocation of the
29 license of a health care provider who has been convicted of a sex crime and
30 to ensure the safety of patients of health care providers by requiring
31 criminal background checks at least once every five (5) years.
