25	(b)(l) Any of the following designations that are <u>A designation that</u>
26	is displayed on each parking space for <del>persons</del> individuals with disabilities
27	and visible to the driver's eye level shall be enforced as provided under
28	this subchapter and <del>are</del> <u>is</u> regulatory in nature <del>:</del> .
29	(A)(2) A sign that displays the blue and white international
30	symbol of access accompanied by one (1) or more of the phrases referenced
31	under subdivision (b)(l)(B) of this section; displayed under subdivision
32	(b)(1) of this section shall display the term, "Reserved" - with the blue and
33	white international symbol of access.
34	(B) A sign that states any of the following:
