AN ACT CONCERNING EXEMPTIONS TO THE PRIVATE
INVESTIGATORS AND PRIVATE SECURITY AGENCIES ACT; AND
FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

CONCERNING EXEMPTIONS TO THE PRIVATE
INVESTIGATORS AND PRIVATE SECURITY
AGENCIES ACT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-40-103(a), concerning exemptions to the
Private Investigators and Private Security Agencies Act, is amended to add a
new subdivision to read as follows:

(16) A person who is an employee or sales representative of an
alarm systems company to the extent that person:

(A) Sells alarm systems only at a store location, online,
or by telephone, but not on site at the end user's premises; and

(B) Does not have access to end user confidential
information regarding the end user's electronic security equipment.
