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29	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 21-2-708(a) and (b), concerning notice of
30	proof of loss, investigations, and remedies under the Self-Insured Fidelity
31	Bond Program, are amended to read as follows:

15	attorney, or the Attorney General assist the state or appropriate political
16	subdivision in filing a civil lawsuit against the public official, officer,
17	or employee if the board determines that civil remedies should be pursued

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20	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 21-2-709(a)(2), concerning the
21	determination of coverage under the Self-Insured Fidelity Bond Program, is
22	amended to read as follows:
23	(2)(A) If the board determines that the loss is covered under
24	the program, the <u>then:</u>
25	(A) The Insurance Commissioner shall authorize fidelity
26	bond loss payments from the Fidelity Bond Trust Fund to the participating
27	governmental entity on a timely basis . ; and
28	(B) The board shall provide:
29	(i) Provide a timely explanation of a loss payment
30	and a denial of loss to the Legislative Auditor and to the participating
31	governmental entity . ; and
32	(ii)(a) Determine whether civil remedies should be
33	pursued to recover the loss.
34	(b) In making a determination under
35	subdivision (a)(2)(B)(ii)(a) of this section, the board shall consider the
36	cost effectiveness of pursuing civil remedies.

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
