Arkansas Code § 21-2-709(a)(2), concerning the 20 determination of coverage under the Self-Insured Fidelity Bond Program, is 21 amended to read as follows: 22 (2)(A) If the board determines that the loss is covered under 23 the program, the then: 24 (A) The Insurance Commissioner shall authorize fidelity 25 bond loss payments from the Fidelity Bond Trust Fund to the participating 26 governmental entity on a timely basis+; and 27 (B) The board shall provide: 28 (i) Provide a timely explanation of a loss payment 29 and a denial of loss to the Legislative Auditor and to the participating 30 governmental entity+; and 31 (ii)(a) Determine whether civil remedies should be 32 pursued to recover the loss. 33 (b) In making a determination under 34 subdivision (a)(2)(B)(ii)(a) of this section, the board shall consider the cost effectiveness of pursuing civil remedies. 35
