7	(c)(l) The Child Abuse Hotline shall accept a report of physical abuse

9	(2) The report shall be determined not to be true if the injury		
10	is a minor temporary mark or causes transient pain and was an acceptable		
11	restraint as provided under this chapter.		
12	(d)(1) The Child Abuse Hotline shall accept a report of physical abuse		
13	<u>child maltreatment</u> involving a bruise to a child even if at the time of the		
14	report the bruise is not visible if the bruising occurred:		
15	(A) Within the past fourteen (14) days; and		
16	(B) As a result of physical abuse <u>child maltreatment</u> as		
17	described under subsections (a)-(c) of this section.		
18	(2) However, the report under this subsection shall not be		
19	determined to be true unless the existence of the bruise is corroborated.		
20	(e) The Child Abuse Hotline shall not accept a report of:		
21	(1) Environmental neglect pertaining to head lice unless the:		
22	(A) Head lice is chronic; or		
23	(B) Alleged victim currently has sores that require		
24	immediate medical attention; or		
25	(2) Educational neglect from a school unless the school has		
26	complied with § 6-18-222.		
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
