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7	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
8	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that it is the state's		
9	constitutional obligation to provide a general, suitable, and efficient free		
10	system of public schools in the state; that many school districts have high		
11	student transportation costs and must use a greater amount of foundation		
12	funding for student transportation than other school districts; that the		
13	student transportation funding and distribution under this act are needed to		
14	ensure that proper resources are provided to public schools and school		
15	districts under the state's constitutional obligation; and that this act is		
16	immediately necessary so that public schools and school districts will		
17	receive the amount of funding provided under this act for the 2013-2014		
18	school year. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this act		
19	being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety		
20	shall become effective on July 1, 2013.		
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
