3	(2)(A) As results are received and tabulated on election night		
4	for all state and federal elections, the county board of election		
5	commissioners shall declare preliminary and unofficial results of the		
6	election as soon as early voting, absentee, or individual precinct results		
7	are tabulated on election night and immediately shall transmit the results		
8	precinct to the Secretary of State through the election night reporting		
9	interface provided by the Secretary of State.		
10	(B) The county board of election commissioners may, by		
11	agreement with the county clerk, transmit the results to the county clerk wh		
12	immediately shall transmit the results by precinct to the Secretary of State		
13	as described under subdivision (2)(A) of this section.		
14	(C) On election night for all state and federal elections,		
15	immediately after the count of the vote is complete, the county board of		
16	election commissioners shall:		
17	(i) Declare preliminary and unofficial results of		
18	the election, including a statement of the number of outstanding:		
19	(a) Ballots of voters who requested ballots		
20	under the Uniformed and Overseas Citizens Absentee Voting Act; and

29	(E) The Secretary of State may establish policies and

31	(3) Within nineteen (19) calendar days after any general,		
32	special, or school election, the county board shall deliver a certificate of		
33	election to the person having the highest number of legal votes for any		
34	county office.		
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SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 7-5-707 is amended to read as follows:

1	7-5-707. Vote certification.
2	(a) For all state and federal elections, the county board of election
3	commissioners shall transmit the certified results for each $\frac{1}{2}$
4	the county clerk, who shall immediately transmit the results to the Secretary
5	of State through the Internet website interface provided by the Secretary of
6	State precinct to the Secretary of State through the election night reporting
7	interface provided by the Secretary of State.
8	(b) The county board may, by agreement with the county clerk, transmit
9	the certified results to the county clerk who shall transmit the certified
LO	results by precinct to the Secretary of State as described in subsection (a)
11	of this section.
12	(b)(c) The Secretary of State may require a county board of election
L3	commissioners to submit additional election information as determined by the
L4	Secretary of State.
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
