10 DUTIES OF A LOCAL BOARD OF A TECHNICAL INSTITUTE; TO

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-51-904(a), concerning the duties of a
23 local board of a technical institute, is amended to read as follows:

24 (a) The powers and duties of the local board shall be as follows:

25 (1) To acquire, hold, and transfer real and personal property,
26 to enter into contracts, to institute and defend legal actions and suits, and
27 to exercise such other rights and privileges as may be necessary for the
28 management and administration of the technical institute;

29 (2) To determine a minimum level for student tuition and fees to
30 be charged by the technical institute, including without limitation penalty
31 fees;

32 ~~(2)(3)~~ (3) To appoint from the candidates certified by the State
33 Board of Workforce Education and Career Opportunities the president of the
34 technical institute or director of the comprehensive lifelong learning
35 center;

36 ~~(3)(4)~~ (4) To appoint, upon nomination of the president or director,



1 the members of the administrative and teaching staffs;

2 ~~(4)~~(5) To determine, with the approval of the state board, the
3 educational program of the institution; and

4 ~~(5)~~(6) Other powers and duties as provided in this subchapter or
5 as delegated to it by the state board.

7 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
8 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that under Arkansas Code § 25-15-
9 105, the authority of technical institutes to charge certain fees currently
10 collected by the institutes will expire on July 1, 2013, and that this act is
11 necessary to allow the technical institutes to continue to collect the
12 revenues they currently receive and to allow the technical institutes to
13 maintain their current level of operation. Therefore, an emergency is
14 declared to exist, and this act being necessary for the preservation of the
15 public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on July 1, 2013.
