23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

25 *SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 18, Subchapter 2, is amended*  
26 *to add an additional section to read as follows:*

27 *6-18-231. Additional absences for Arkansas National Guard members.*

28 *A student who joins the Arkansas National Guard at seventeen (17) years*  
29 *of age while in grade eleven (11) shall be granted additional absences at the*  
30 *discretion of the school district superintendent in order to complete basic*  
31 *combat training between grades eleven (11) and twelve (12).*
