26	(a) The Adjut	ant General acting for and on behalf of	the Arkansas

 - (c) No A armory readiness center or facility, or its facilities or portions threof, shall not be rented for less than an amount sufficient to cover all expenses, including custodian fees, utility bills, janitor service, and any repairs occasioned by such use.
 - (d)(1) Armory Readiness center funds are those funds derived from the use of the facilities by an individual, agency, or organization other than the official users of the facilities by National Guard units quartered therein. Social meetings for members of a unit and their families, sponsored by the unit, are considered official.
 - (2) A full and complete record of funds received and disbursed will shall be maintained by the senior officer of the official using the unit and shall be subject to audit as may be required by the Adjutant General.
 - (3) The Adjutant General will shall publish rules and regulations governing the expenditure of such rental funds with a limitation of ten percent (10%) of the annual income limited to unit social purposes to ensure that the state expenses are recovered from the rental funds and that rental funds are used for Arkansas National Guard morale, welfare, and recreation events.
