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1 (1) "Committee" means the Residential Building Contractors 2 Committee created by this subchapter; 3 (2) "Home improvement contractor" means any person, firm, 4 partnership, co-partnership, association, corporation, or other organization 5 or any combination that attempts to or submits a bid, or contracts, 6 undertakes, or assumes charge in a supervisory capacity or otherwise manages 7 the reconstruction, alteration, renovation, repair, modification, 8 improvement, removal, demolition, or addition to any preexisting single 9 family residence or the property and structures appurtenant thereto; 10 (3)(2) "Residential building contractor" means any person, firm, 11 partnership, copartnership, association, corporation, or other organization 12 or any combination thereof, which for a fixed price, commission, fee, or 13 wage, attempts to submit or submits a bid to construct or contract or 14 undertakes to construct or assumes charge in a supervisory capacity or 15 otherwise manages the construction of a single family residence or the 16 property and structures appurtenant thereto residences; and 17 (4)(3) "Single family residence" means any project consisting of 18 one (1) but not more than four (4) units of new construction for residential 19 occupancy when the cost of the project is twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) 20 or more. This definition does not apply to subcontractors of licensed 21 residential building contractors or to remodeling operations. 22 23 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 17-25-506(a)(1), concerning application for 22 license, is amended to read as follows: 23 17-25-506. Application for license. 24 (a) Applications for licensure shall be made on forms prescribed by 25 the Residential Building Contractors Committee and shall have attached 26 thereto: 27 (1) (A) Except as provided in subdivision (a)(1)(B) of this 28 section, a compiled financial statement with each application for all persons 29 and entities required by this subchapter to be licensed by the committee when 30 the cost of the work done or to be done in the State of Arkansas by the 31 contractor, including without limitation labor and materials, is twenty 32 thousand dollars (\$20,000) or more. 33 (B) A person or entity required to be licensed under this 34 subchapter when the cost of the work done or to be done in the State of 35 Arkansas by the contractor, including without limitation labor and materials, is less than twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) shall not be required to 36

Arkansas Code § 17-25-508 is amended to read as follows: Name of licensed contractor. 28 17-25-508. 29 Contractors licensed under this subchapter Residential building 30 contractors may act as such residential building contractors only in the name 31 under which they are licensed by the Residential Building Contractors 32 Committee. 33 34 SECTION 9. Arkansas Code § 17-25-510 is amended to read as follows: 23 17-25-510. Hearings regarding violations. 24 (a) The Residential Building Contractors Committee may conduct 25 hearings regarding alleged violations of this subchapter or regulations 26 promulgated thereunder, and the hearings shall be conducted in accordance 27 with the Arkansas Administrative Procedure Act, § 25-15-201 et seq. The 28 committee within a reasonable time shall within a reasonable time make 29 findings and determinations as a result of the hearings. 30 (b) A contractor who, after notice and hearing, is found to have committed the following actions shall pay to the Contractors Licensing Board 31 32 a civil penalty of not less than one hundred dollars (\$100) nor more than 33 four hundred dollars (\$400) for each day that the violation occurred: 34 (1) Acting as a contractor without having a valid license in 35 violation of this chapter; 36 (2) Using a contractor in violation of this chapter;

Aggrieved parties shall be granted an opportunity to 22 address the board regarding the committee's actions, and the final actions of 23 the board shall be binding upon the committee. 24 25 SECTION 12. Arkansas Code § 17-25-512 is amended to read as follows: 26 17-25-512. Expiration of license - Fees. 27 All licenses issued by the Contractors Licensing Board shall expire one 28 (1) year after the date of issuance unless otherwise provided by the 29 Residential Building Contractors Committee. The committee may charge 30 reasonable examination fees and delinquency fees and may charge a fee not to 31 exceed one hundred dollars (\$100) a for new licenses license or renewal of a 32 license.
