16	district shall provide a copy of the audit report to the Department of		
17	Education.		
18	(C) Annually by October 1, the department shall:		
19	(i) Compile a list of the reports of noncompliance		
20	received under this section; and		
21	(ii) Provide the list to the House Committee on		
22	Education and the Senate Committee on Education.		
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
