2	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code Title 26, Chapter 3, Subchapter 3, is amended		
3	to add an additional section to read as follows:		
4	26-3-311. Additional homestead exemption.		
5	A taxpayer who is eligible for a homestead property tax exemption under		
6	<u>§ 26-26-1118 shall receive an additional homestead property tax exemption in</u>		
7	the amount of one hundred dollars (\$100) for each child:		
8	(1) For whom the taxpayer is the parent or guardian;		
9	(2) Who is at least five (5) years of age but not more than		
10	seventeen (17) years of age; and		
11	(3) Who is either:		
12	(A) Enrolled in a private school; or		
13	(B) Attending a home school as defined in § 6-15-501.		
14			
15	SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This act is effective for assessment years		
16	beginning on or after January 1, 2013.
