2	(d) A person who knowingly fails or refuses to post the sign required
3	by this section is guilty of a violation and shall be fined in an amount not
4	to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100) for each violation of this section.
5	(e) The board may enter into an interagency agreement with the Office
6	of Alcohol and Drug Abuse Prevention regarding the funding necessary to
7	implement this section.
