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20	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 25, Chapter 1, Subchapter 1, is amended
21	to add a new section to read as follows:
22	25-1-121. Prohibition against use of certain location information.
23	(a) As used in this section:
24	(1) "Electronic device" means a device that enables access to or
25	use of:
26	(A) An electronic communication service as defined in 18
27	<u>U.S.C. § 2510(15), as it existed on January 1, 2013;</u>
28	<u>(B) A remote computing service as defined in 18 U.S.C. §</u>
29	2711(2), as it existed on January 1, 2013; or
30	(C) A location information service; and
31	(2) "Location information" means information concerning the
32	location of an electronic device that, in whole or in part, is generated by
33	or derived from the operation of that device.
34	(b) It is unlawful for the State of Arkansas, a state agency, or a
35	political subdivision of the state to obtain location information unless:
36	(1) A court has issued a valid search warrant under the Arkansas

2	(2) The State of Arkansas, a state agency, or a political
3	subdivision:
4	(A) Obtains location information under circumstances it
5	determines constitute an emergency situation that:
6	(i) Involves:

10	national security; or

13	(ii) Requires obtaining the location information

17	(3) The State of Arkansas, a state agency, or a political
18	subdivision of the state is responding to a call for emergency services made
19	by the user of the electronic device;
20	(4) The owner or user of the electronic device consents; or
21	(5) A court with jurisdiction has ordered the release of the
22	information under a valid court order.
23	(c) This section does not prohibit the collection of information
24	<u>otherwise permitted under Arkansas law.</u>
