7 **HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION**

8 TO PROVIDE FOR RECESS OF THE EIGHTY-NINTH GENERAL
9 ASSEMBLY AT THE CLOSE OF BUSINESS ON APRIL 19, 2013;
10 TO PROVIDE FOR AN EXTENSION OF THE REGULAR SESSION OF
11 THE EIGHTY-NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY UNTIL 12:00 NOON,
12 MAY 17, 2013, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSIDERING VETOES,
13 CORRECTING ERRORS OR OVERSIGHTS, COMPLETING ITS WORK
14 ON PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS, CONSIDERING
15 ANY ISSUES THAT MAY ARISE CONCERNING AMENDMENT 82
16 AUTHORIZED PROJECTS, AND CONSIDERING THE NEED FOR
17 FURTHER EXTENSION OF THE REGULAR SESSION OR TO
18 ADJOURN THE EIGHTY-NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY AT ANY TIME
19 BEFORE THAT DATE IF THEY DETERMINE THAT THERE IS NO
20 NEED TO RECONVENE; AND TO PROVIDE THAT IF THE GENERAL
21 ASSEMBLY IS NOT RECONVENED OR ADJOURNED BEFORE 12:00
22 NOON, MAY 17, 2013, THE REGULAR SESSION OF THE
23 EIGHTY-NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY IS ADJOURNED SINE DIE
24 ON THAT DATE.

28 TO PROVIDE FOR AN EXTENSION OF THE
29 REGULAR SESSION OF THE EIGHTY-NINTH
30 GENERAL ASSEMBLY; AND TO PROVIDE FOR A
31 RECESS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

34 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-NINTH GENERAL
35 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

1 (a) That the Regular Session of the Eighty-Ninth General Assembly of
2 the State of Arkansas is extended until 12:00 noon, May 17, 2013;

3 (b) That under Arkansas Constitution, Article 6, § 15, prior to
4 adjournment of the General Assembly, the Governor is afforded five (5) days
5 after receipt of a bill to sign a bill or veto a bill, therefore from April
6 19, 2013, to May 17, 2013, the House of Representatives and the Senate shall
7 be open so the office of the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives and
8 the office of the Secretary of the Senate may receive communications, vetoes
9 of bills by the Governor, and notification of errors and oversights;

10 (c) That the Regular Session of the Eighty-Ninth General Assembly of
11 the State of Arkansas shall enter into recess simultaneously at the close of
12 business in each chamber on April 19, 2013, or at such earlier time as may be
13 agreed upon by the House of Representatives and the Senate;

14 (d) That the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President
15 Pro Tempore of the Senate may, by joint proclamation:

16 (1) Reconvene the General Assembly at any time before 12:00
17 noon, May 17, 2013, for the purpose of:

18 (A) Considering vetoes;

19 (B) Correcting errors and oversights;

20 (C) Completing its work on proposed constitutional
21 amendments;

22 (D) Considering any issues that may arise concerning
23 Amendment 82 authorized projects; and

24 (E) Considering the need for further extension of the
25 Regular Session of the Eighty-Ninth General Assembly; or

26 (2) Adjourn the Regular Session of the Eighty-Ninth General
27 Assembly at any time before 12:00 noon, May 17, 2013, if they determine it is
28 not necessary to reconvene; and

29 (e) That if the General Assembly is not reconvened or adjourned before
30 12:00 noon, May 17, 2013, the Regular Session of the Eighty-Ninth General
31 Assembly is adjourned sine die on that date.
