22	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE
23	STATE OF ARKANSAS AND BY THE SENATE, A MAJORITY OF ALL MEMBERS ELECTED TO
24	EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:

26	THAT the following is proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of
27	the State of Arkansas, and upon being submitted to the electors of the state
28	for approval or rejection at the next general election for Representatives
29	and Senators, if a majority of the electors voting thereon at the election
30	adopt the amendment, the amendment shall become a part of the Constitution of
31	the State of Arkansas, to wit:

33	SECTION 1. Section 2 of Amendment 73 to the Constitution of Arkansas
34	is amended to read as follows:
35	§ 2. Legislative Branch.
36	(a) The Arkansas House of Representatives shall consist of members to



1	be chosen every second year by the qualified electors of the several
2	counties. No member of the Arkansas House of Representatives may serve more
3	than three such two year terms.
4	(b) The Arkansas Senate shall consist of members to be chosen every
5	four (4) years by the qualified electors of the several districts. No member
6	of the Arkansas Senate may serve more than two such four year terms.
7	(c)(l)(A) A member of the General Assembly shall serve no more than
8	fourteen (14) years.
9	(B) However, a member who completes his or her fourteenth
10	year of office during a term of office for which he or she has been elected
11	may serve until the completion of that term of office.
12	(2) The years of service in either the House of Representatives
13	or the Senate, or both:
14	(A) Need not be served consecutively; and
15	(B) Shall be added together to determine the total number
16	of years in office.
17	(3) A partial legislative term served as a result of a special
18	election under Article 5, § 6, or a two-year term served as a result of
19	apportionment shall not be included in calculating the total number of years
20	served by a member of the General Assembly.
21	(4) This subsection shall not apply to an active member of the
22	General Assembly who is serving in the House of Representatives or the Senate
23	on the date this amendment is adopted.
