21	WHEREAS, the Second Amendment to the Constitution of the United States
22	reads as follows, "A well regulated militia, being necessary to the security
23	of a free state, the right of the people to keep and bear arms, shall not be
24	infringed"; and

26	WHEREAS, the right to keep and bear arms has benefited the State of
27	Arkansas, its economy, and its citizens; and
28	
29	WHEREAS, generations of Arkansans have enjoyed and benefited from the
30	lifestyle fostered by the freedoms and protection granted by the Second
31	Amendment; and

33	WHEREAS, the right to keep and bear arms should not be abridged,
34	infringed upon, or in any way limited by the action of any branch of the
35	federal government or a state or local government,

1 NOW THEREFORE,

2 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-NINTH GENERAL
3 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

5 THAT the House of Representatives encourages all branches of federal, 6 state, and local government to respect and preserve the rights guaranteed by 7 the Second Amendment to the United States Constitution, and opposes any 8 action that would abridge, infringe upon, or limit the right to keep and bear 9 arms.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the chief clerk of the House of Representatives distribute a copy of this resolution to the President of the United States, the Vice President of the United States, the President Pro Tempore of the United States Senate, the Speaker of the United States House of Representatives, the chief executive officer of each legislative chamber for each of the fifty (50) state legislatures within the United States, and each member of the Arkansas Congressional Delegation.
