8 TO DESIGNATE THE MONTH OF MARCH AS "MULTIPLE SYSTEM  
9 ATROPHY AWARENESS MONTH" TO INCREASE PUBLIC AWARENESS  
10 OF THIS PROGRESSIVE NEURODEGENERATIVE DISORDER THAT  
11 AFFECTS THE AUTONOMIC FUNCTIONS OF THE BODY.

15 TO DESIGNATE THE MONTH OF MARCH AS  
16 "MULTIPLE SYSTEM ATROPHY AWARENESS MONTH"  
17 TO INCREASE PUBLIC AWARENESS OF THIS  
18 PROGRESSIVE NEURODEGENERATIVE DISORDER  
19 THAT AFFECTS THE AUTONOMIC FUNCTIONS OF  
20 THE BODY.

23 WHEREAS, multiple system atrophy is a neurodegenerative disorder that  
24 affects many of the autonomic body systems such as loss of balance and  
25 coordination, fainting and dizziness due to severely low blood pressure,  
26 bladder and bowel issues, speech and swallowing difficulties, sleep  
27 disturbances, breathing problems, and rigidity and tremors similar to  
28 Parkinson's disease or amyotrophic lateral sclerosis (ALS); and

29  
30 WHEREAS, multiple system atrophy generally affects middle-aged men and  
31 women and advances rapidly with the progressive loss of motor skills and  
32 eventually confinement to bed, and death; and

33  
34 WHEREAS, people rarely live 15 years with multiple system atrophy; and

35  
36 WHEREAS, there is no remission from multiple system atrophy and



1 currently no cure; and

2  
3 WHEREAS, the current lack of awareness of multiple system atrophy leads  
4 to misdiagnosis and mistreatment, as well as misdirected research funding  
5 that could be better applied to finding a cure for multiple system atrophy,

7 NOW, THEREFORE,

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-NINTH GENERAL  
9 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

11 THAT the House of Representatives designates the month of March as  
12 "Multiple System Atrophy Awareness Month" to increase public awareness of  
13 this progressive neurodegenerative disorder that affects the autonomic  
14 functions of the body.
