20 won the 2012 Southland Conference Tournament, after four straight regular-

25 tournament for the first time in school history; and

27 WHEREAS, the University of Central Arkansas Sugar Bears volleyball team
28 won 30 games during the 2012 season, one of only 7 schools in the nation to
29 do so; and

31 WHEREAS, senior outside hitter Jessica Hays was named the Southland
32 Conference volleyball student-athlete of the year and the Southland
33 Conference Tournament Most Valuable Player; and

35 WHEREAS, junior setter Marissa Collins was named the Southland
36 Conference's Setter of the Year for the second time and the fourth time in



1 five (5) years that the award has gone to a Sugar Bear; and

3 WHEREAS, Marissa Collins, Jessica Hays, and sophomore middle blocker
4 Alicia Dittrich, earned First Team All-Southland Conference honors; and

6 WHEREAS, senior Taylor Hammonds earned All-Southland Conference
7 Honorable Mention honors for the second time after ranking second in the
8 conference with a .383 hitting percentage and leading the Sugar Bears with 71
9 blocks; and

11 WHEREAS, David McFatrigh, coach of the University of Central Arkansas
12 Sugar Bears volleyball team, inspires his athletes to excellence by
13 encouraging their focus on team, each other, and hard work; and

15 WHEREAS, sports and athletics are challenging and stimulating, and the
16 continued success of the University of Central Arkansas Sugar Bears
17 volleyball team is a tribute to their talent, hard work, and leadership, with
