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23	SECTION 1. AI	PPROPRIATION - SENATE EXPENSES. There is her	eby
24	appropriated, to th	ne Arkansas Senate, to be payable from the Co	onstitutional
25	Officers Fund, for	the fiscal year ending June 30, 2013, the fo	llowing:
26	(A) for Milea	age Allowances, Per diem, Maintenance and Gen	leral

31	SECTION 2. SH	PECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO) THE ARKANSAS

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Auditor and the State Auditor shall cause transfer to be made from one item
to another.

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4 SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 5 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 6 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 7 8 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 9 10 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 11 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 12 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 14 15 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 16 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 17 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 18 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 19 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 20 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 21 22

23 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 24 Assembly that the Arkansas Senate of the 89th General Assembly convenes in 25 regular session on January 14, 2013; that expenses of the session begin 26 immediately; and that the expenses are a just expense of the state which must 27 be paid at the time the services are provided. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate 28 29 preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force 30 and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval. If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on 31 32 the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the 33 bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, it 34 shall become effective on the date the last house overrides the veto. 35

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
