SECTION 2. TEMPORARY LANGUAGE. DO NOT CODIFY. By August 30, 2013, the Commission for Arkansas Public School Academic Facilities and Transportation shall appoint the new members of the Advisory Committee on Public School Academic Facilities added under this act. At the first meeting of the committee that occurs on or after August 30, 2013, all members shall draw for new terms of either a term to expire on April 1, 2017, or a term to expire on April 1, 2021. A member shall not serve more than eight (8) years on the committee. /s/Elliott
