14	TO CREATE A TASK FORCE TO STUDY THE
15	TAXATION OF NONALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.

18	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
19	
20	SECTION 1. DO NOT CODIFY. <u>Legislative Task Force on the Taxation of</u>
21	<u>Nonalcoholic Beverages - Creation.</u>
22	(a) There is established a legislative task force to be known as the
23	"Legislative Task Force on the Taxation of Nonalcoholic Beverages".
24	(b) The task force shall be composed of the following members:
25	(1) Five (5) members appointed by the President Pro Tempore of
26	the Senate as follows:
27	(A) Two (2) members of the Senate, one of whom shall be
28	appointed to serve as cochair of the task force;
29	(B) One (1) representative of a retail chain operating in
30	<u>the state;</u>
31	(C) One (1) owner or operator of a fast food restaurant
32	located in the state; and
33	(D) One (1) owner or operator of a full-service restaurant
34	located in the state;
35	(2) Five (5) members appointed by the Speaker of the House of
36	Representatives as follows:

1	(A) Two (2) members of the House of Representatives, one
2	of whom shall be appointed to serve as cochair of the task force;
3	(B) One (1) wholesaler actively engaged in the soft drink
4	industry in the state;
5	(C) One (1) owner or operator of a fast food restaurant
6	located in the state; and
7	(D) One (1) owner or operator of a full-service restaurant
8	located in the state;
9	(3) The Executive Director of the Arkansas Hospitality
10	Association;
11	(4) The Chancellor of the University of Arkansas for Medical
12	Sciences or his or her designee;
13	(5) The Director of the Department of Human Services or his or
14	her designee; and
15	(6) One (1) representative of an organization that receives
16	funds from the taxes imposed on nonalcoholic beverages, who shall be
17	appointed by the cochairs of the task force.
18	(c) The task force shall:
19	(1) Meet at a location within the state at the call of the
20	cochairs; and
21	(2) Establish rules and procedures for conducting the business
22	of the task force.
23	(d) Legislative members of the task force are entitled to per diem and
24	mileage at the same rate authorized by law for attendance at meetings of
25	interim committees of the General Assembly.
26	(e) The task force shall receive staff support from the Bureau of
27	<u>Legislative Research.</u>
28	(f) Vacancies on the task force shall be filled in the same manner as
29	provided for the initial appointment.
30	
31	SECTION 2. DO NOT CODIFY. <u>Duties.</u>
32	The Legislative Task Force on the Taxation of Nonalcoholic Beverages
33	<u>shall:</u>
34	(1) Perform a detailed and comprehensive study of the wholesale
35	taxes imposed on nonalcoholic beverages in the state, including without
36	limitation the taxes levied under the Arkansas Soft Drink Tax Act, § 26-57-

1	<u>901 et seq.;</u>
2	(2) Seek input and gather information from appropriate sources
3	to enable the task force to fulfill its duties under this section; and
4	(3) Report the written findings and recommendations of the task
5	force to the Governor, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, and the
6	Speaker of the House of Representatives on or before September 1, 2014.
7	
8	SECTION 3. DO NOT CODIFY. Expiration.
9	The Legislative Task Force on the Taxation of Nonalcoholic Beverages
10	shall expire on January 1, 2015.
