7	wrapping, or sealing animal feed products; and		
8	(2) Consumed during use or disposed of		
9	after use.		
10	(b) "Expendable supplies for farm machinery"		
11	includes without limitation baling twine, net wrap, silage wrap, and cotton		
12	wrap.		
13	(c) "Expendable supplies for farm machinery"		
14	does not include supplies and parts used for maintenance, repair, or		
15	replacement purposes;		
16	<u>(iii)(a) "Farm machinery" means implements used</u>
