19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-26-102 is amended to read as follows:		
22	(a) As used in this chapter:		
23	(1) "Aesthetician" means any person who engages in the practice		
24	of beautifying the body by cleaning, waxing, externally manipulating, or		
25	stimulating the body by means of the hands, devices, apparatus, or appliances		
26	with or without the use of cosmetic preparations, antiseptics, tonics,		
27	lotions, and creams;		
28	(2) "Cosm	netological establishment" means	any premises, building,
29	or part of a building in which is practiced any branch or any combination of		
30	branches of cosmetology or the occupation of a cosmetologist except:		
31	(A)	The branch of manicuring as pr	acticed in barbershops
32	licensed by the Cosmetology Technical Advisory Committee and complying with		
33	the provisions of this chapter; and		
34	<i>(B)</i>	Nursing facilities as defined	under § 20-10-1401;

- 6 (4) "Electrologist" means any person who permanently removes
- 7 hair from or destroys hair on the human body for beautification by the use of
- 8 an electric needle or by the use of any other kinds of devices or appliances
- 9 designed to permanently remove hair from the human body;
- 10 (5) "Manager-operator" means a licensed cosmetologist authorized
- 11 to engage in the practice of cosmetology, independent of personal supervision
- 12 in a duly licensed establishment;
- 13 (6) "Manicurist" means any person who engages in the occupation
- 14 of manicuring the nails of any person by cutting, trimming, polishing,
- 15 coloring, tinting, cleansing, filing, buffing, pushing, extending,
- 16 protecting, wrapping, covering, building, or beautifying the nails or
- 17 performing any other similar work upon the nails of any person by any means,
- 18 including the softening of the arms, hands, feet, or ankles of any person by
- 19 use of hands, mechanical or electrical apparatus or appliances, cosmetic or
- 20 chemical preparations, antiseptics, lotions, or creams or by massaging,
- 21 cleansing, manipulating or stimulating the arms, hands, feet, or ankles of
- 22 any person; and
- 23 (7) "Postsecondary school of cosmetology" means a school of
- 24 <u>cosmetology that offers a postsecondary curriculum approved by the Department</u>
- 25 <u>of Health</u>;
- 26 <u>(8) "School of cosmetology" means a person, firm, or corporation</u>
- 27 <u>licensed by the State and exacting a fee for the teaching of any branch of</u>
- 28 cosmetology; and
- 29 <u>(9)</u> "Student" means any person enrolled and engaged in learning
- 30 or acquiring a knowledge of the occupation of cosmetology or any branch of
- 31 cosmetology in a licensed school of cosmetology under a licensed instructor.
- 32 (b) The art of cosmetology includes any and all and any combination of
- 33 the following practices:
- 34 (1) Arranging, dressing, curling, waving, machineless permanent
- 35 waving, permanent waving, cleansing, cutting, singeing, bleaching, tinting,
- 36 coloring, straightening, dyeing, brushing, beautifying, or otherwise treating

- 1 by any means the hair of any person or wigs or hairpieces;
- 2 (2) Externally manipulating, cleaning, waxing, or stimulating
- 3 the body by means of the hands, devices, apparatus, or appliances with or
- 4 without the use of cosmetic preparations, antiseptics, tonics, lotions, or
- 5 creams;
- 6 (3) Beautifying the body by use of cosmetic preparations,
- 7 antiseptics, tonics, lotions, or creams;
- 8 (4) Temporarily removing superfluous hair from the body of any
- 9 person by the use of depilatories or by the use of tweezers, chemicals, or
- 10 preparations or by the use of devices or appliances of any kind or
- 11 description, except by the use of light waves, commonly known as rays;
- 12 (5) Cutting, trimming, polishing, tinting, coloring, cleansing,
- 13 or manicuring the nails of any person; and
- 14 (6) Massaging, cleansing, or beautifying the nails of any
- 15 person.
- 16 (c) The branch of electrolysis, a practice of cosmetology requiring a
- 17 separate course of training as prescribed by § 17-26-306, includes
- 18 permanently removing hair from or destroying hair on the human body by the
- 19 use of an electric needle or by the use of any other kind of device or
- 20 appliance designed to permanently remove hair from the human body.
- 21 (d) Every person, firm, or corporation exacting a fee for the teaching
- 22 of any branch of cosmetology is classed as a school of cosmetology under this
- 23 chapter and is required to comply with all of its provisions.

- 25 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 17-26-205, concerning powers and duties of
- 26 the Department of Health, is amended to add an additional subdivision as
- 27 *follows:*
- 28 (d)(1) The department shall promulgate rules setting a standard
- 29 <u>educational curriculum for schools of cosmetology.</u>
- 30 <u>(2) The standard educational curriculum shall distinguish</u>
- 31 <u>between secondary and postsecondary educational requirements for the schools</u>
- 32 of cosmetology.

- 34 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 17-26-403, concerning licenses to operate
- 35 schools of cosmetology, is amended to add an additional subdivision to read
- 36 as follows:
