21	SECTION 1. Ark	kansas Code § 23-2-101 is amended t	o read as follows:
22	23-2-101. Membe	ers generally.	
23	(a)(l) The Ark	cansas Public Service Commission sh	all consist of three
24	(3) members to be kno	own as commissioners <del>, one (1) of wh</del>	om shall be a lawyer.
25	(2) Each	n commissioner shall have resided i	n the state for five
26	(5) years and shall b	pe a qualified elector.	
27	(b) Each commi	issioner before entering on his or	her duties shall take
28	the oath prescribed b	by the Constitution, shall swear th	at he or she is not
29	pecuniarily intereste	ed in any public utility or affilia	te, or any public
30	carrier or affiliate	therewith, as employee, stockholde	er, or security holder.
31	(c) Each commi	issioner shall execute a bond to th	e State of Arkansas in
32	the sum of ten thousa	and dollars (\$10,000), conditioned	for the faithful
33	discharge and perform	mance of his or her duties.	
34	(d) Each commi	issioner shall receive an annual sa	lary of five thousand
35	dollars (\$5,000), pay	vable semimonthly or monthly in con	formity with
36	prevailing practices	of other officers of the state.	

1	(e)(1) $\underline{(A)}$ At the expiration of each of the commissioner's terms, the
2	Governor, subject to the approval of the Senate, shall appoint one (1) member
3	who Each commissioner shall hold office for a term of six (6) years.
4	$\frac{(2)}{(B)}$ Each commissioner shall hold office during the term for
5	which he or she was appointed and until his or her successor is appointed and
6	qualified.
7	(2)(A) Two (2) commissioners shall be appointed by the Governor
8	subject to the approval of the Senate.
9	(B) One (1) commissioner appointed by the Governor shall
10	<u>be a lawyer.</u>
11	(3)(A) One (1) commissioner shall be appointed by the President
12	Pro Tempore of the Senate or the Speaker of the House of Representatives.
13	(B) The President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the
14	Speaker of the House of Representatives shall alternate who appoints the
15	commissioner at the expiration of each term for that commissioner.
16	(f) The Governor shall designate one (1) of the commissioners as
17	chair.
18	(g) If there is a vacancy in office of a commissioner, the person who
19	originally appointed the commissioner shall appoint a person to the
20	commission to finish that commissioner's term.
21	
22	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 23-2-102(a), concerning appointment of
23	special commissioners to the Arkansas Public Service Commission, is amended
24	to read as follows:
25	(a) When <del>any</del> <u>a</u> member of the Arkansas Public Service Commission is
26	disqualified for any reason to hear and participate in the determination of
27	any a matter pending before the commission, the Governor person who
28	originally appointed the commission member shall appoint a qualified person
29	to hear and participate in the decision on the particular matter.
30	
31	SECTION 3. DO NOT CODIFY. TEMPORARY LANGUAGE. A member of the
32	Arkansas Public Service Commission shall not be removed from office upon the
33	effective date of this act. The first commissioner who finishes his or her
34	six-year term after the effective date of this act shall be replaced by the
35	appointment of the President Pro Tempore of the Senate. Upon completion of
36	the President Pro Tempore of the Senate's appointed commissioner's term, the

2	That position on the commission shall continue to be appointed by alternating
