2 (4)(A) For each member who first became a member before July 1, 1971, member contributions for the period after June 30, 1969, shall be six 3 4 percent (6%) of the first seven thousand eight hundred dollars (\$7,800) of his or her annual salary through June 30, 2013, unless he or she shall have 5 6 elected, in accordance with rules and regulations established by the Board of 7 Trustees of the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System, to contribute six percent 8 (6%) of his or her full salary for the period after June 30, 1969, through 9 June 30, 2013.

10 (B) <u>Beginning July 1, 2013, each member who first became a</u> 11 <u>member before July 1, 1971, shall contribute to the system the percentage of</u> 12 <u>salary set by the board under subdivision (b)(8) of this section on the first</u> 13 <u>seven thousand eight hundred dollars (\$7,800) of his or her annual salary</u> 14 <u>unless he or she elects to contribute a percentage of his or her entire</u> 15 <u>salary, in accordance with the rules established by the board.</u>

16 (C) If the election is made before July 1, 1984, the 17 member shall contribute to the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System system the 18 difference between full salary member contributions and member contributions 19 based on seven thousand eight hundred dollars (\$7,800) annual covered salary 20 retroactive to July 1, 1969, or to the actual date of employment, whichever 21 is later, by paying the actuarial equivalent of the member's benefits to the 22 system.

23 (G)(D) If the election is made July 1, 1984, or later, the 24 member shall contribute to the system both the added member contributions and 25 the added employer contributions that would have been paid to the system if 26 the member's full salary always had been covered by paying the actuarial 27 equivalent of the member's benefits to the system.

28 (D)(E) The interest and added employer contributions shall 29 be considered member contributions for purposes of the system. However, any 30 former active member who returns to covered employment on or after July 1, 31 1995, and who elects to make contributions to the system, shall contribute on 32 his or her full salary.

(5) Members who left covered employment before July 1, 1985, and
who had annual compensation of seven thousand eight hundred dollars (\$7,800)
or less shall have, upon their return to covered employment, full salary
considered for purposes of the system.

1	(6) Contributions shall be required on all salary earned in		
2	covered employment during the fiscal year in which membership begins.		
3	(7) The member contribution rate shall be six percent (6%)		
4	unless increased by the board.		
5	(8)(A) The board may set the member contribution rate between		
6	six percent (6%) and eight percent (8%) subject to the limitations under		
7	subdivision (b)(8)(D) of this section.		
8	(B) An increase or decrease in a member contribution rate		
9	shall:		
10	(i) Apply to a complete fiscal year; and		
11	(ii) Remain in effect until modified by the board.		
12	(C) The board may adopt a change in the member		
13	contribution rate by resolution at any board meeting.		
14	(D) The board shall not increase the member contribution		
15	rate unless the system's actuary recommends an increase to the board in order		
16	to address an amortization period in excess of thirty (30) years to pay the		
17	unfunded liabilities of the system.

19	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
20	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that provisions of the Arkansas		
21	Teacher Retirement System Act are in need of revision and updating to bring		
22	the retirement laws into conformance with sound public pension policy; that		
23	the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System member contributions may need to be		
24	adjusted from time to time to keep the system financially sound and to		
25	provide a proper retirement benefit to all its members; and that this act is		
26	immediately necessary to maintain an orderly system of benefits for members		
27	of the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System. Therefore, an emergency is		
28	declared to exist, and this act being immediately necessary for the		
29	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective		
30	<u>on:</u>		
31	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;		
32	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,		
33	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the		
34	bill; or		
35	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
36	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
