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14	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
15	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the release of records to the		
16	general public concerning persons licensed to carry a concealed handgun is an		
17	unwarranted invasion of privacy and threatens the safety and property of the		
18	persons identified; and that this act is immediately necessary to prevent		
19	harm to citizens and safeguard their property. Therefore, an emergency is		
20	declared to exist, and this act being immediately necessary for the		
21	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective		
22	on:		
23	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;		
24	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,		
25	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the		
26	bill; or		
27	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
28	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.		
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
