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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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12 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Arkansas
 13 State Game and Fish Commission for the 2013-2014 fiscal year, the following
 14 maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra
 15 Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: one hundred
 16 eighty-five (185) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of
 17 pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and
 18 Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate
 19 classification.

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21 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated,
 22 to the Arkansas State Game and Fish Commission, to be payable from the Game
 23 Protection Fund, for personal services, operating expenses, acquisition,
 24 maintenance and improvements of the Arkansas State Game and Fish Commission
 25 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014, the following:

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 24 SECTION 5. APPROPRIATION - CONSERVATION PARTNERS PROGRAM GRANTS. There
 25 is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas State Game and Fish Commission, to be
 26 payable from the Game Protection Fund, for grants to conservation partners,
 27 or other eligible entities for operating, equipment, and maintenance expenses
 28 associated with addressing statewide hunger needs, for the fiscal year ending
 29 June 30, 2014, the following:

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 35 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 36 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. HUNTERS

1 FEEDING THE HUNGRY. Arkansas Hunters Feeding the Hungry is designed to share
2 the harvest of an abundant resource with Arkansans' who are in need of food,
3 partner with the Game and Fish Commission in order to provide a solution for
4 a healthy, balanced deer herd, provide a much needed free, low fat, high
5 protein food source to the many feeding agencies and organizations across
6 Arkansas and create a provider purpose for hunters who participate, allowing
7 them to give back and share with others. In order to help sustain the
8 Arkansas Hunters Feeding the Hungry program in Arkansas the Arkansas Game and
9 Fish Commission may establish a check off or other appropriate methods to
10 raise revenue for support of the program. The intent of this Section is to
11 encourage the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission to examine opportunities
12 available to provide support for the Arkansas Hunters Feeding the Hungry
13 program.

14 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2012~~
15 2013 through June 30, ~~2013~~ 2014.

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17 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
18 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. PAYMENT
19 OF REWARDS. Payment of rewards shall be from the Game Protection Fund from
20 the Commission's Maintenance and General Operation appropriation as herein
21 appropriated in Section 3, Item No. (05)(A).

22 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2012~~
23 2013 through June 30, ~~2013~~ 2014.

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25 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
26 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. EXTRA
27 HELP RESTRICTION. No employee of the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission who is
28 employed as extra help may receive an amount to exceed eighty-five percent
29 (85%) of the maximum annual salary for a comparable position as authorized
30 under § 21-5-201 et seq. during any fiscal year, nor shall such an employee
31 be employed for a period of time to exceed one thousand eight hundred (1,800)
32 hours in any single fiscal year.

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34 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
35 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
36 PROVISION. After receiving approval from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the

1 State, and prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
2 Committee, the Agency is authorized to transfer appropriation from any line
3 item authorized in Section 3 Operations to any other line item authorized in
4 Section 3 and the Agency is authorized to transfer appropriation from any
5 line item authorized in Section 4 Gas Lease Revenues to any other line item
6 authorized in Section 4.

7 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2013
8 through June 30, 2014.

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10 SECTION 10. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
11 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
12 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
13 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
14 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
15 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
16 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
17 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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19 SECTION 11. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
20 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
21 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
22 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2013 is essential to the operation of
23 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
24 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
25 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2013 could work irreparable harm
26 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
27 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
28 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
29 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2013.
