Arkansas Hunters Feeding the Hungry is designed to share 3 the harvest of an abundant resource with Arkansans' who are in need of food, 4 partner with the Game and Fish Commission in order to provide a solution for 5 a healthy, balanced deer herd, provide a much needed free, low fat, high 6 protein food source to the many feeding agencies and organizations across 7 Arkansas and create a provider purpose for hunters who participate, allowing 8 them to give back and share with others. In order to help sustain the 9 Arkansas Hunters Feeding the Hungry program in Arkansas the Arkansas Game and 10 Fish Commission may establish a check off or other appropriate methods to 11 raise revenue for support of the program.
