Arkansas Code § 24-10-506(a)(1), concerning other local 8 police and fire service, is amended to read as follows: 9 (a) Any An active member of the Arkansas Local Police and Fire Retirement System shall be entitled to purchase credited service in the 10 11 system equivalent to a period not to exceed fifteen (15) years if the member: 12 (1)(A) Has at least five (5) years of actual service with the 13 system;. 14 (B) A member hired on or after July 1, 2013, shall accrue 15 ten (10) years of actual service in order to be eligible for purchase under this section; 16 17 18 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 24-10-508 is amended to read as follows: 19 24-10-508. Service credit. 20 (a) Any An active member of the Arkansas Local Police and Fire 21 Retirement System who has at least five (5) years of actual service and who 22 has service in an Arkansas law enforcement agency or fire department and who 23 has been employed as a public safety or law enforcement officer in any agency 24 not covered by the system or any other system that is reciprocal to the 25 system shall receive credited service for that service. 26 (b) A member hired on or after July 1, 2013, shall accrue ten (10) 27 years of actual service in order to be eligible under this section. 28 29 SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 24-10-510(a), concerning service credit for 30 former military personnel, is amended to read as follows: 31 (a) Any An active member of the Arkansas Local Police and Fire Retirement System may purchase credited service in the system equivalent to a 32 period not to exceed five (5) years for service rendered by the member while 33 on active duty in the armed forces of the United States before the member's 34 35 employment covered by the system, if the member:

(1) Received an honorable discharge from the armed forces;

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1 (2)(A) Has at least five (5) years of actual service in the 2 system; and. 3 (B) A member hired on or after July 1, 2013, shall accrue 4 ten (10) years of actual service in order to be eligible for purchase under 5 this section; and 6 (3)(A) Contributes to the system an amount that is the actuarial 7 equivalent of the value of the credited service to be purchased. 8 (B) The actuarial equivalent is of the time of the 9 purchase of the credited service and shall be determined by the actuary for 10 the system. 11 12 SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 24-10-604(a), concerning voluntary 13 retirement application, is amended to read as follows: 14 (a)(1) Any A member in covered employment may retire with an annuity 15 provided for in § 24-10-602 upon his or her written application to the Board 16 of Trustees of the Arkansas Local Police and Fire Retirement System setting 17 forth at what time, not less than at least thirty (30) days nor but not more 18 than ninety (90) days subsequent to the execution and filing of his or her 19 application, he or she desires to be retired, but only if, at the time of his 20 or her separation from employment and at the time so specified for his or her 21 retirement, the member shall have attained his or her normal retirement age 22 and have five (5) years of credited service in force. 23 (2) A member hired on or after July 1, 2013, shall accrue ten (10) years of actual service in order to be eligible under this section. 24 25 SECTION 6. Arkansas Code § 24-10-607(a), concerning disability 26 27 retirement, is amended to read as follows: 28 (a)(1)(A)(i) Any An active member with five (5) years of credited 29 service, including credited service for seventy-five percent (75%) of the two (2) years immediately preceding his or her disability, who while an active 30 31 member becomes totally and permanently physically or mentally incapacitated for any suitable duty as an employee as a result of a personal injury or 32 disease may be retired by the Board of Trustees of the Arkansas Local Police 33 34 and Fire Retirement System upon written application filed with the board by or on behalf of the member or former member. 35 36 (ii) A member hired on or after July 1, 2013, shall

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1 accrue ten (10) years of actual service in order to be eligible for 2 retirement. 3 (B) The employee shall be retired only if, after a medical 4 examination of the member or former member made by or under the direction of a physician or physicians designated by the board, the physician reports to 5 6 the plan board in writing that the member or former member is physically or 7 mentally totally incapacitated for the further performance of any suitable 8 duty, that the incapacity will probably be permanent, and that the member or 9 former member should be retired. 10 (2) A written application to the board by the member or former 11 member or on behalf of the member shall be filed with the board not later 12 than one (1) year after the termination of active membership. 13 (3) The disability annuity shall be effective the first day of 14 the calendar month next following the later of: 15 (A) His or her termination of active membership; or 16 (B) Six (6) months before the date the written application 17 is filed with the board. 18 SECTION 7. Arkansas Code § 24-10-609, concerning the death of a member 19 20 in volunteer service, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as 21 follows: 22 (e) A member hired on or after July 1, 2013, shall accrue ten (10) 23 years of actual service in order to be eligible for benefits under this 24 section. 25 SECTION 8. Arkansas Code § 24-10-611(a)(1), concerning termination of 26 27 covered employment, is amended to read as follows: 28 (a) A member who terminates covered employment before attaining his or 29 her normal retirement age, for a reason other than death, early retirement, or disability retirement, shall be entitled to an annuity computed in 30 31 accordance with the provisions of this section, as it provides at the time of the last termination of covered employment, subject to the member's 32 satisfying all of the following conditions: 33 34 (1)(A) The member has five (5) years of credited service;. 35 (B) A member hired on or after July 1, 2013, shall accrue 36 ten (10) years of actual service in order to be eligible for retirement;

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2	SECTION 9. Arkansas Code § 24-10-613(a), concerning disposition of
3	accumulated contributions, is amended to read as follows:
4	(a)(1) If <u>On or after July 1, 2013, if</u> a retirant and his or her
5	eligible beneficiary, if any, both die before they have received in annuity
6	payments a total amount equal to the accumulated contributions , including any
7	interest credits standing to the retirant's credit in the Arkansas Local
8	Police and Fire Retirement System at the time of his or her retirement, the
9	difference between the accumulated contributions and the total amount of
10	annuities received by them shall be paid to the persons the retirant
11	nominated by written designation duly executed and filed with the Board of
12	Trustees of the Arkansas Local Police and Fire Retirement System.
13	(2) If no designated person survives the retirant and his or her
14	beneficiary, the difference shall be paid to the estate of the survivor of
15	the retirant and his or her beneficiary.
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17	SECTION 10. Arkansas Code § 24-10-704, concerning the rate of return
18	on benefits, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:
19	(c)(l) When a member has reached year six (6) of participation in the
20	Local Police and Fire Deferred Retirement Option Plan under § 24-10-706, the
21	amount of the benefit calculated at the time of enrollment in the plan shall
22	be redetermined consistent with § 24-10-602.
23	(2) The redetermined amount shall be the amount of the benefit
24	as of the immediately preceding July 1 increased by three percent (3%).
25	(3) The redetermined amount shall be payable only when the
26	member elects to cease employment and receive a service retirement and shall
27	not be added to the plan account.
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29	SECTION 11. Arkansas Code § 24-10-706 is amended to read as follows:
30	24-10-706. Duration.
31	(a) The duration of participation in the Local Police and Fire
32	Deferred Retirement Option Plan for active paid service police officers and
33	firefighters shall not exceed five (5) <u>seven (7)</u> years.
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34	(b) At the conclusion of a member's participation in the plan, the
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1	member had retired at the time the member elected to participate in the plan.
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3	SECTION 12. Arkansas Code § 24-12-109(c)(1), concerning investments,
4	is amended to read as follows:
5	(c)(l) In those nonuniformed employees' pension and relief funds in
6	which assets exceed one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000), the board of
7	trustees may employ:
8	(A) An investment advisor as defined in § 24-10-402(a)(2)(A)(ii)
9	to invest the assets, subject to the terms, conditions, limitations, and
10	restrictions imposed by law upon the Arkansas Local Police and Fire
11	Retirement System, as provided by § 24-10-401 et seq. Public Employees'
12	<u>Retirement System;</u> and
13	(B) A trustee or custodian to hold the assets.
14	(2) The investments shall not be limited to interest-bearing bonds.
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16	SECTION 13. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
17	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the local police and fire
18	retirement systems provide economic security for eligible citizens of
19	Arkansas; that the statutes need amending to update and clarify existing law;
20	and that these changes need to be made immediately. Therefore, an emergency
21	is declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the
22	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective
23	<u>on July 1, 2013.</u>
