8	AN ACT TO ADDRESS MEMBER DEPOSIT ACCOUNTS IN THE
9	ARKANSAS LOCAL POLICE AND FIRE RETIREMENT SYSTEM; TO
10	ADDRESS TECHNICAL CHANGES IN THE ARKANSAS LOCAL
11	POLICE AND FIRE RETIREMENT SYSTEM; TO EXTEND THE
12	DEFERRED RETIREMENT OPTION PLAN IN THE ARKANSAS LOCAL
13	POLICE AND FIRE RETIREMENT SYSTEM; TO ADDRESS COST OF
14	LIVING INCREASES FOR CERTAIN MEMBERS OF THE ARKANSAS
15	LOCAL POLICE AND FIRE RETIREMENT SYSTEM; TO DECLARE
16	AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

20	TO ADDRESS MEMBER DEPOSIT ACCOUNTS,
21	TECHNICAL CHANGES, COST OF LIVING
22	INCREASES, AND THE DEFERRED RETIREMENT
23	OPTION PLAN IN THE ARKANSAS LOCAL POLICE
24	AND FIRE RETIREMENT SYSTEM.
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27	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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29	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 24-10-407(d), concerning income-expense
30	accounts, is amended to read as follows:
31	(d)(1) $\underline{(A)}$ At the end of each system fiscal year, the board shall
32	credit each member's individual account in the members' deposit account with
33	regular interest on the average balance in the account for the fiscal year.
34	(B) Beginning July 1, 2013, the board shall cease awarding
35	interest to each member's deposit account.
36	(2) At the end of each system fiscal year, the board shall

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1 credit to each account in the employer accumulation account regular interest 2 on the average balance in the account for the fiscal year and similarly shall 3 credit regular interest to the retirement reserve account. 4 (3) The regular interest shall be transferred from the income-5 expense account. 6 7 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 24-10-506(a)(1), concerning other local 8 police and fire service, is amended to read as follows: 9 (a) Any An active member of the Arkansas Local Police and Fire Retirement System shall be entitled to purchase credited service in the 10 11 system equivalent to a period not to exceed fifteen (15) years if the member: 12 (1)(A) Has at least five (5) years of actual service with the 13 system;. 14 (B) A member hired on or after July 1, 2013, shall accrue 15 ten (10) years of actual service in order to be eligible for purchase under 16 this section; 17 18 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 24-10-508 is amended to read as follows: 19 24-10-508. Service credit. 20 (a) Any An active member of the Arkansas Local Police and Fire 21 Retirement System who has at least five (5) years of actual service and who 22 has service in an Arkansas law enforcement agency or fire department and who 23 has been employed as a public safety or law enforcement officer in any agency 24 not covered by the system or any other system that is reciprocal to the 25 system shall receive credited service for that service. 26 (b) A member hired on or after July 1, 2013, shall accrue ten (10) 27 years of actual service in order to be eligible under this section. 28 29 SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 24-10-510(a), concerning service credit for 30 former military personnel, is amended to read as follows: 31 (a) Any An active member of the Arkansas Local Police and Fire Retirement System may purchase credited service in the system equivalent to a 32 period not to exceed five (5) years for service rendered by the member while 33 on active duty in the armed forces of the United States before the member's 34

(1) Received an honorable discharge from the armed forces;

1	(2) $\underline{(A)}$ Has at least five (5) years of actual service in the
2	system ; and .
3	(B) A member hired on or after July 1, 2013, shall accrue
4	ten (10) years of actual service in order to be eligible for purchase under

7	equivalent of the value of the credited service to be purchased.
8	(B) The actuarial equivalent is of the time of the
9	purchase of the credited service and shall be determined by the actuary for
10	the system.
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12	SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 24-10-604(a), concerning voluntary
13	retirement application, is amended to read as follows:
14	(a) $\underline{(1)}$ Any \underline{A} member in covered employment may retire with an annuity
15	provided for in § 24-10-602 upon his or her written application to the Board
16	of Trustees of the Arkansas Local Police and Fire Retirement System setting
17	forth at what time, not less than <u>at least</u> thirty (30) days nor <u>but not</u> more
18	than ninety (90) days subsequent to the execution and filing of his or her
19	application, he or she desires to be retired, but only if, at the time of his
20	or her separation from employment and at the time so specified for his or her
21	retirement, the member shall have attained his or her normal retirement age
22	and have five (5) years of credited service in force.
23	(2) A member hired on or after July 1, 2013, shall accrue ten
24	(10) years of actual service in order to be eligible under this section.
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26	SECTION 6. Arkansas Code § 24-10-605, concerning compulsory
27	retirement, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:
28	(c) A member hired on or after July 1, 2013, shall accrue ten (10)
29	years of actual credited service in order to be eligible under this section.
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31	SECTION 7. Arkansas Code § 24-10-607(a), concerning disability
32	retirement, is amended to read as follows:
33	(a)(1)(A) <u>(i)</u> Any An active member with five (5) years of credited
34	service, including credited service for seventy-five percent (75%) of the two
35	(2) years immediately preceding his or her disability, who while an active
36	member becomes totally and permanently physically or mentally incapacitated

1	for any suitable duty as an employee as a result of a personal injury or
2	disease may be retired by the Board of Trustees of the Arkansas Local Police
3	and Fire Retirement System upon written application filed with the board by
4	or on behalf of the member or former member.
5	(ii) A member hired on or after July 1, 2013, shall
6	accrue ten (10) years of actual service in order to be eligible for
7	retirement.
8	(B) The employee shall be retired only if, after a medical
9	examination of the member or former member made by or under the direction of
10	a physician or physicians designated by the board, the physician reports to
11	the plan <u>board</u> in writing that the member or former member is physically or
12	mentally totally incapacitated for the further performance of any suitable
13	duty, that the incapacity will probably be permanent, and that the member or
14	former member should be retired.
15	(2) A written application to the board by the member or former
16	member or on behalf of the member shall be filed with the board not later
17	than one (1) year after the termination of active membership.
18	(3) The disability annuity shall be effective the first day of
19	the calendar month next following the later of:
20	(A) His or her termination of active membership; or
21	(B) Six (6) months before the date the written application
22	is filed with the board.
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24	SECTION 8. Arkansas Code § 24-10-608, concerning death of a member in
25	paid service, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:
26	(g) A member hired on or after July 1, 2013, shall accrue ten (10)
27	years of actual credited service in order to be eligible under this section.
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29	SECTION 9. Arkansas Code § 24-10-609, concerning the death of a member
30	in volunteer service, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as
31	follows:
32	(e) A member hired on or after July 1, 2013, shall accrue ten (10)
33	years of actual service in order to be eligible for benefits under this
34	section.

SECTION 10. Arkansas Code § 24-10-611(a)(1), concerning termination of

1 covered employment, is amended to read as follows: 2 (a) A member who terminates covered employment before attaining his or 3 her normal retirement age, for a reason other than death, early retirement, 4 or disability retirement, shall be entitled to an annuity computed in 5 accordance with the provisions of this section, as it provides at the time of 6 the last termination of covered employment, subject to the member's 7 satisfying all of the following conditions: 8 (1)(A) The member has five (5) years of credited service;. 9 (B) A member hired on or after July 1, 2013, shall accrue 10 ten (10) years of actual service in order to be eligible for retirement; 11 12 SECTION 11. Arkansas Code § 24-10-613(a), concerning disposition of 13 accumulated contributions, is amended to read as follows: 14 (a)(1) If On or after July 1, 2013, if a retirant and his or her 15 eligible beneficiary, if any, both die before they have received in annuity 16 payments a total amount equal to the accumulated contributions, including any 17 interest eredits standing to the retirant's credit in the Arkansas Local 18 Police and Fire Retirement System at the time of his or her retirement, the 19 difference between the accumulated contributions and the total amount of 20 annuities received by them shall be paid to the persons the retirant 21 nominated by written designation duly executed and filed with the Board of 22 Trustees of the Arkansas Local Police and Fire Retirement System. 23 (2) If no designated person survives the retirant and his or her 24 beneficiary, the difference shall be paid to the estate of the survivor of 25 the retirant and his or her beneficiary. 26 27 SECTION 12. Arkansas Code § 24-10-704, concerning the rate of return 28 on benefits, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows: 29 (c)(1) When a member has reached year six (6) of participation in the 30 Local Police and Fire Deferred Retirement Option Plan under § 24-10-706, the amount of the benefit calculated at the time of enrollment in the plan shall 31 be redetermined consistent with § 24-10-602. 32 33 (2) The redetermined amount shall be the amount of the benefit as of the immediately preceding July 1 increased by three percent (3%). 34 35 (3) The redetermined amount shall be payable only when the 36 member elects to cease employment and receive a service retirement and shall

1	<u>not be added to the plan account.</u>
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3	SECTION 13. Arkansas Code § 24-10-706 is amended to read as follows:
4	24-10-706. Duration.
5	(a) The duration of participation in the Local Police and Fire
6	Deferred Retirement Option Plan for active paid service police officers and
7	firefighters shall not exceed five (5) seven (7) years.
8	(b) At the conclusion of a member's participation in the plan, the
9	member shall terminate employment with the employer and shall start receiving
10	the member's monthly retirement benefit that would have been received if the
11	member had retired at the time the member elected to participate in the plan.
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13	SECTION 14. Arkansas Code § 24-12-109(c)(1), concerning investments,
14	is amended to read as follows:
15	(c)(1) In those nonuniformed employees' pension and relief funds in
16	which assets exceed one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000), the board of
17	trustees may employ:
18	(A) An investment advisor as defined in § 24-10-402(a)(2)(A)(ii)
19	to invest the assets, subject to the terms, conditions, limitations, and
20	restrictions imposed by law upon the Arkansas Local Police and Fire
21	Retirement System, as provided by § 24-10-401 et seq. Public Employees'
22	Retirement System; and
23	(B) A trustee or custodian to hold the assets.
24	(2) The investments shall not be limited to interest-bearing bonds.
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26	SECTION 15. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
27	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the local police and fire
28	retirement systems provide economic security for eligible citizens of
29	Arkansas; that the statutes need amending to update and clarify existing law;
30	and that these changes need to be made immediately. Therefore, an emergency
31	is declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the
32	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective
33	<u>on July 1, 2013.</u>
