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23	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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25	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 24-7-501(a), concerning membership in the
26	Arkansas Teacher Retirement System,, is amended to add an additional
27	subdivision to read as follows:
28	"(3)(A) School resource officers who are qualified under this
29	subdivision and elect to participate in the system on or after July 1, 2013.
30	(B) To participate in the system, a school resource
31	officer shall be:
32	(i) An Arkansas certified law enforcement officer;
33	and
34	<u>(ii) Employed primarily to provide services at a</u>
35	system employer.
36	(C) A school resource officer shall not receive retirement

1	<u>credit for the same service or salary in another public retirement system in</u>
2	<u>Arkansas.</u>
3	(D)(i) A system employer may authorize a school resource
4	officer who is indirectly paid by the system employer to participate as a
5	member of the system by adopting a resolution.
6	(ii) A resolution adopted by the system employer
7	<u>shall:</u>
8	(a) Authorize a school resource officer
9	employed by the system employer to participate as a member of the system; and
10	(b) State the employer's agreement to act as
11	the system employer for the purpose of reporting service, paying
12	contributions to the system on behalf of a school resource officer, and
13	performing all member services as if the school resource officer were
14	directly employed by the system employer.
15	(iii) A school resource officer paid indirectly by a
16	<u>system employer is not eligible to participate as a system member unless the</u>
17	system employer explicitly authorizes such participation by resolution.
18	(E)(i) The salary and service used to determine
19	contributions and benefits in the system shall be based on the salary paid to
20	the school resource officer for performing the services of a school resource
21	officer for the system employer.
22	(ii) If an employer reimburses another public entity
23	for the payment of the school resource officer's salary and salary related
24	costs, the employer receiving the employment services of the school resource
25	officer shall be the system employer for the purpose of system participation
26	and not the direct public employer.
27	<u>(iii) If a system employer pays all or part of a</u>
28	school resource officer's salary indirectly by reimbursing a law enforcement
29	agency in Arkansas, the system shall treat all salary indirectly paid by the
30	system employer to the school resource officer as if it had been paid by the
31	<u>system employer directly.</u>
32	(F) If a school resource officer becomes a member of the
33	system and his or her salary is paid indirectly by a system employer, then
34	the only contribution due on the salary shall be the employer contribution
35	payable to the system.
