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28	SECTION 1. Arka	nsas Code § 24-7-202(27), conc	erning the definition of
29	"salary", is amended t	o read as follows:	
30	(27)(A) "	'Salary" means the remuneration	paid to a member

34	(B)	"Salary" includes:	
35		(i) An incentive bonus paid	to an employee for the

1 Standards under § 6-17-413 if the Department of Education pays the employer 2 contribution and the member pays the required member contribution; and 3 (ii) Employer pick-up contributions, cafeteria plans 4 as defined in § 21-5-901, and employee contributions to qualified retirement 5 plans, including without limitation qualified annuities and deferred 6 compensation plans. 7 (C) "Salary" does not include: 8 (i) All or part of a payment made as a result of a 9 contract buyout agreement, settlement, claim, judgment, arbitration award, 10 decree, or court-ordered payment to a member on which the employer is 11 required to withhold federal income tax from wages unless the amount paid to 12 the member is higher than the wages earned by the member for regular service; 13 and 14 (ii) Nonmonetary taxable income including without 15 limitation vehicles, housing, and personal property. 16 (D) The board may promulgate rules to modify the 17 definition of salary used in the calculation of benefits by the system; 18 19 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 24-7-735 is amended to read as follows: 20 24-7-735. Contract buyout agreement -- Settlements -- Judgments --21 Calculation of benefits. 22 (a) A member shall not accumulate additional service credit in the 23 Arkansas Teacher Retirement System during the time that payments under a 24 contract buyout agreement, settlement, claim, judgment, arbitration award, 25 decree, or court-ordered payments payment are paid to the member by the employer unless the member continues to work on-site for the employer. 26 27 Employer contributions shall be payable to the system on payments 28 made under subsection (a) of this section to the member on which the employer 29 is required to withhold federal income tax as if the payments were made under 30 § 24-7-708 if the member does not continue to work on-site for the employer. 31 (c)(1) The employer shall provide a copy of a settlement agreement or 32 court order under this section to the system to calculate any contributions 33 due to the system, or service credit and salary due to the member. 34 (2) A member shall not receive service credit or salary from the system under a settlement agreement or court order unless permitted under 35 36 this section.

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1	(d) The system shall allow a member to purchase service credit under a		
2	settlement agreement or court order to resolve a claim of wrongful		
3	termination if the service credit is:		
4	(1)(A) Purchased from the date of termination by an employer to		
5	the date of the settlement agreement, court order, or other resolution of the		
6	dispute.		
7	(B) Service credit earned by the member from an employer		
8	from the date of termination by an employer to the date of the settlement		
9	agreement or court order shall be subtracted from the amount of service		
10	credit allowed for purchase under subdivision (d)(l)(A) of this section; and		
11	(2) Paid using the actuarial equivalent, as calculated by the		
12	system, of the member's benefits to the system.		
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14	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 24-7-737 is repealed.		
15	24-7-737. Salary contracts - Additional remuneration.		
16	(a) A member may establish salary earned under a contract that is		
17	bought-out by a covered employer by paying employee and employer		
18	contributions plus interest.		
19	(b) In determining salary, a retirement annuity may be based on		
20	service credit covered by the purchased contract.		
21	(c)(1) Employment contracts purchased by a covered employee or won		
22	through litigation that results in either a consent agreement, judgment, or		
23	decree may be counted as salary upon payment of all required member and		
24	employer contributions, including interest, to the Arkansas Teacher		
25	Retirement System.		
26	(2) A member who receives remuneration under a regular contract		
27	and a purchased contract or under both a regular contract and a contract won		
28	through litigation, consent agreement, judgment, or decree shall have the		
29	greater of the two (2) amounts considered as salary for the purposes of		
30	determining the final average salary of the member.		
31	(d) If a member's salary includes remuneration paid other than in		
32	cash, the cash value of the remuneration is considered in the amount the		
33	employer is required to report for federal income tax purposes.		
34	(e) A contributory member's contributions and an employer's		
35	contributions are required on covered salary, including:		
36	(1) Contributions that are paid concurrently with other		

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1	remuneration for another covered employer or used in calculating member		
2	benefits; and		
3	(2) Salary that is paid concurrently with other remuneration		
4	from another covered employer, even if the salary is not used in calculating		
5	member benefits.		
6	(f) Retirement annuities may be based on service credit covered by a		
7	purchased contract.		
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9	SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
10	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that provisions of the Arkansas		
11	Teacher Retirement System Act are in need of revision to bring them into		
12	conformance with sound public pension policy; that the Arkansas Teacher		
13	Retirement System must administer member's accounts in certain situations		
14	involving a claim or dispute to which the system is not a party but for which		
15	clear rules are necessary; and that this act is immediately necessary to		
16	maintain an orderly system of benefits for the members of the Arkansas		
17	Teacher Retirement System. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and		
18	this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public		
19	peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:		
20	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;		
21	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,		
22	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the		
23	bill; or		
24	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
25	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
