15 TO MAKE TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS CONCERNING
16 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES TO TITLE 3 OF THE
17 ARKANSAS CODE.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
21

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 3-3-203(a)(2), concerning the purchase or
23 possession of alcohol by a minor, is amended to read as follows to clarify a
24 term:

25 (2) For the purposes of this section, intoxicating liquor, wine,
26 or beer in the body of a ~~minor~~ person under twenty-one (21) years of age is
27 deemed to be in his or her possession.
28

29 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 3-4-205(b)(1)(B), concerning interest in
30 other liquor permits, is amended to read as follows to clarify its
31 application:

32 (B) A retail liquor permit shall apply only to one (1)
33 location, and a person, firm, or corporation issued a retail liquor permit
34 shall not be permitted to receive any direct or indirect financial benefit
35 from the sale of liquor at any location other than the permitted location.

1 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 3-9-240(f)(4), concerning hotel or large-
 2 event facility private club permits, is amended to read as follows to clarify
 3 its application:

4 (4)(A) A hotel holding a hotel or large-event facility private
 5 club permit under this section may lease a sleeping room to a hotel or large-
 6 event facility private club permittee for the service of alcoholic beverages.

7 (B) The hotel holding a hotel or large-event facility
 8 private club permit may use room service to serve the alcoholic beverage.

9 (C) The hotel holding a hotel or large-event facility
 10 private club permit may stock the leased sleeping room with alcoholic
 11 beverages and the hotel or large-event facility private club permittee
 12 through the hotel’s employees shall inventory the alcoholic beverages in the
 13 leased sleeping room.

14 (D) Sleeping rooms that are solely occupied by persons
 15 twenty (20) years of age and under shall not receive alcoholic beverages
 16 through room service or be stocked with alcoholic beverages.

17
 18 SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 3-9-240(h), concerning hotel or large-event
 19 facility private club permits, is amended to read as follows to clarify its
 20 application:

21 (h)(1)(A) The application ~~by~~ and renewal fee for a hotel for a hotel
 22 or large-event facility private club permit ~~shall be accompanied by an annual~~
 23 ~~permit fee of~~ is one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500) per year payable
 24 on or before June 30 of each calendar year for the fiscal year beginning July
 25 1.

26 (B) In an area in which the sale of intoxicating liquor
 27 has not been authorized by local option as provided under § 3-8-201 et seq.,
 28 the application for a hotel or large-event facility private club permit shall
 29 be accompanied by an additional application fee of one thousand five hundred
 30 dollars (\$1,500).

31 ~~(C) The annual renewal fee for a hotel holding a hotel or~~
 32 ~~large event facility private club permit is one thousand five hundred dollars~~
 33 ~~(\$1,500).~~

34 (2) The application and renewal fee for a large-event facility
 35 for a hotel or large-event facility private club permit is two thousand five
 36 hundred dollars (\$2,500) per year payable on or before June 30 of each

1 calendar year for the fiscal year beginning July 1.

2
3 SECTION 5. DO NOT CODIFY. The enactment and adoption of this act
4 shall not repeal, expressly or impliedly, the acts passed at the regular
5 session of the Eighty-Ninth General Assembly. All such acts shall have the
6 full force and effect and, so far as those acts intentionally vary from or
7 conflict with any provision contained in this act, those acts shall have the
8 effect of subsequent acts and as amending or repealing the appropriate parts
9 of the Arkansas Code of 1987.
