22	AUTHORITY. The Director of the Department of Education $-$ Di	vision of Public
23	School Academic Facilities and Transportation, with the app	roval of the Chief
24	Fiscal Officer of the State and after approval by the Arkan	sas Legislative
25	Council or Joint Budget Committee, is hereby authorized to	request necessary
26	appropriation transfers and any other budget related adjust	ments necessary

35	Determining the maximum number of employees and the m	aximum amount of
36	appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agenc	y each fiscal year

1 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by 2 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and 3 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by 4 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly 5 has determined that the Department of Education - Division of Public School 6 Academic Facilities and Transportation may operate more efficiently if some 7 flexibility is provided to the Director of the Department of Education -8 Division of Public School Academic Facilities and Transportation authorizing 9 broad powers under the Transfer Authority provision herein. Therefore, it is 10 both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight 11 by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget 12 Committee as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this 13 14 section. If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint 15 Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent 16 jurisdiction, this entire section is void.

17 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, $\frac{2012}{100}$ 2013 through June 30, $\frac{2013}{100}$ 2014.

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SECTION 8. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative

2	SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
4	General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
5	the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
6	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2013 is essential to the operation of
7	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
8	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
9	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2013 could work irreparable harm
10	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
11	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
12	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
13	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2013.
