     ten (10) or more years of actual service to be eligible for benefits under
     the system; that some members of the General Assembly are retired from other

     reciprocal systems in the state and may not serve as public employees under

     the system for ten (10) or more years; that the state is making contributions
 6
     on behalf of these members of the General Assembly; that it is in the best
 7
     interests of the state to allow certain members of the General Assembly to

     opt out of membership in the system; and that this act is necessary because
9
     the ideal time to make revisions to the system is at the beginning of the
     fiscal year, which starts on July 1 of each year. Therefore, an emergency is
